

*Supplies List for Summer Saturdays: Garden, August 22*

*Seed Saving: Beans or Umbellifer*

- Dried beans, peas, or other seed in pods
- Brown paper bag
- A shallow bowl, box, or pie tin (we will use this is to help clean your seed of debris)
- Small storage container such as an envelope, a bag, a ½ pint canning jar

*Seed Saving: Hand Crossing*

- Any squash family plant in bloom such as summer squash, winter squash, pumpkin, or zucchini
- Clothes pin, masking tape, or a large paperclip
- Permanent marker, pencil, or ballpoint pen
- Stake or yard flag, if you don't have those you could use a popsicle stick, a paint stirrer or even a stick
- Small storage container such as an envelope, a bag, a ½ pint canning jar

*Making an 18th-Century Seed Packet*

- Several pieces of paper cut into rectangles measuring 3.25 x 4.5 inches. Office paper, construction paper, and writing paper are all good choices.
- A pen, pencil, or other writing implement
- Seeds
