

Supplies List for Summer Saturdays: Games, July 11

Make a game of Quoits

- Scissors
- Tape: scotch tape works best, but you can also use packing or duct tape.
- Drawing, coloring, or decorating materials: markers, colored pencils, and stickers are all good choices.
- Paper towel roll or other long, skinny tube made of unbreakable materials, such as a thermos, shampoo bottle, or shortened wrapping paper roll
- 6 paper plates
- A ruler
- Writing materials: a pen or pencil
- *Optional*, materials to make or use as rings:
 - 18" cord or rope (such as 550 cord)
 - 3-4 twist ties
 - Cardboard
 - Pie ring
 - Child's belt

Bubbles

- One disposable straw per person
- A small bowl or jar
- 3 tablespoons dish soap
- 1 cup water
